### **Preamble**

On 28 September 2011, the Commission issued Broadcasting Notice of Consultation 2011-625 calling for applications for a broadcasting licence to carry on a radio programming undertaking to serve Toronto, Ontario. The Commission also indicated that applicants were to provide all of the information requested in the appendices to that notice of consultation and that failure to do so would cause the application to not be considered as part of this process.

On 30 November 2011, the Commission issued Broadcasting Notice of Consultation 2011-625-1 which made public the aggregated financial information relating to ethnic radio stations in the Toronto radio market for the 2006-2010 fiscal years.

### **Items 1 to 23**

In response to this call, the Commission received several applications to serve the Toronto market.

Of these applications, items 1 to 22 are technically mutually exclusive, each proposing the use of the frequency 88.1 MHz. These applications, along with item 23 will be treated as competitive radio applications for the Toronto radio market.

### **Alternate frequencies**

None of the applicants proposed alternate frequencies. However, 2308739 Ontario Inc. (Item 9) identified an alternate set of technical parameters for frequency 88.1 MHz and provided documentation in support of its technical suitability.

In light of the above and consistent with the approach set out in the call for applications announced in Broadcasting Notice of Consultation 2011-625, the Commission will not consider alternate frequencies for these applications.

### **Items 24 and 25**

The Commission has also received two applications to serve Markham, Ontario. Although the applications are not technically mutually exclusive, the nature of the applications and the technical parameters proposed are such that the two will be treated as competitive radio applications for Markham as well as the Toronto market.

### **Items 26 to 34**

The Commission intends to consider, subject to interventions, items 26 to 34 during the non-appearance phase of the hearing.

#### **1. Toronto, Ontario Application 2011-1159-1**

Application by **Dufferin Communications Inc.** to amend the broadcasting licence for the commercial English-language radio programming undertaking CIRR-FM Toronto.

The licensee proposes to change the frequency of CIRR-FM from 103.9 MHz (channel 280A1) to 88.1 MHz (channel 201A). The licensee also proposes to relocate its transmitter and to change the authorized contours by increasing the average effective radiated power (ERP) from 128 to 477 watts (maximum ERP from 250 to 800 watts with an effective height of antenna above average terrain from 156 to 272 metres), and by changing its class from A1 to A.

The licensee states that this technical amendment is necessary for the financial viability of the station and to solve interference and reception issues affecting the community it is currently licensed to serve.

The Commission may withdraw this application from the public hearing if it is not advised by the Department of Industry, at least twenty days prior to the hearing, that the application is technically acceptable.
